



**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
The Federal Laboratory Consortium for Technology Transfer
And
Maryland Technology Development Corporation**

Purpose

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) develops and expands a framework of cooperation between Maryland Technology Development Corporation and the Federal Laboratory Consortium for Technology Transfer to provide complementary services to each other's organizations and related stakeholders.

Parties

The Parties to this MOU are Maryland Technology Development Corporation (TEDCO) a body politic and corporate and a public instrumentality of the State of Maryland, (TEDCO), located at 5565 Sterrett Place, Suite 214, Columbia, Maryland 21044, and the Federal Laboratory Consortium for Technology Transfer, a nationwide network of federal laboratories organized under the Federal Technology Transfer Act of 1986 (FLC), located at 1001 Connecticut Ave NW, Suite 735, Washington, DC 20036.

Term(s) of MOU

This MOU dated March 9, 2010 by and between TEDCO and the FLC will be in effect until **March 21, 2013**. This MOU may be extended for a period of up to three (3) years upon mutual agreement approximately sixty (60) days prior to the expiration date. This MOU may be terminated with thirty (30) days written notice by either Party with the acknowledgement that pre-arranged marketing commitments will be honored if an event or program takes place within thirty (30) days unless mutually agreed. The MOU shall not be assigned or transferred by either Party, except as authorized in writing by the other Party to this MOU.

Program Implementation

A Point of Contact (POC) shall be assigned by each Party. The TEDCO and FLC POCs will govern management of this MOU. The POCs will be responsible for the development of a strategic plan that is mutually acceptable for programs of common interest, collaborative projects, shared resources and opportunities where both organizations will benefit. The POC for each Party will receive approval and endorsement from the senior principal or board of the Party prior to implementation.

Intellectual Property and Protection of Information

The conduct of research, development, surveys and/or databases that may potentially generate intellectual property will be agreed under a separate agreement from this MOU with the inclusion of separate Proprietary Information Agreements as deemed necessary.

Scope of Activity

Whereas TEDCO conducts meetings and exhibits, and has many promotional and advertising vehicles (print and web-based), and FLC conducts meetings and exhibits, and also has many promotional and advertising vehicles (print and web-based, including a national newsletter entitled *FLC NewsLink*), and each Party desires to trade exhibit space at specific exhibitions and other promotional opportunities; the Parties hereto agree as follows:

FLC will receive from TEDCO:

- Two full complimentary event registrations for TEDCO Technology Showcases (typically four per year) through the term of this MOU.
- One exhibit space with basic furnishings (6' draped table or equivalent, 2 chairs, carpet and wastebasket) at the TEDCO Technology Showcases to be held approximately four times a year. All expenses related to exhibit, including but not limited to, freight and material handling charges, A/V, power, are not included in this agreement
- Sponsor Identification on name Badges at TEDCO Technology Showcases
- Special recognition on annual meeting/conference signage at TEDCO Technology Showcases
- Sponsor recognition in the TEDCO Technology Showcase program handout material
- FLC logo with link on the TEDCO Technology Showcase webpage
- FLC logo prominently displayed during TEDCO Technology Showcases
- A link from the TEDCO web site to the FLC web site
- FLC Annual Meeting listed on the TEDCO website calendar under featured events sixty (60) days prior to the FLC annual meeting
- One blast e-mail message promoting the FLC annual meeting to be sent to all TEDCO contacts

TEDCO will receive from FLC:

- One full complimentary conference registration (including awards banquet) for the annual FLC National Meeting.
- One exhibit space at the FLC National Meeting Tech Fair with basic furnishings (6' draped table or equivalent, 2 chairs, carpet and wastebasket). All expenses related to exhibit, including but not limited to, freight and material handling charges, A/V, power, are not included in this agreement
- A link from the FLC web site to the TEDCO web site and advertisement of the TEDCO Technology Showcases to be listed on the FLC home page under featured events sixty (60) days prior to the TEDCO Technology Showcases (no more than four per year) and in the two prior NewsLink publications
- One featured article in an appropriate FLC publication about appropriate TEDCO activities of interest to FLC readers.
- One blast email to the FLC active database promoting TEDCO Technology Showcases to be sent out 30 days prior to each event

The parties hereto agree that the market value of the goods or services received by TEDCO is no less than equal to the value of the goods or services received by FLC, and that no further compensation or fee is due to either as a part of this transaction.
